Harvey Norman have been proclaiming that the wood from their Australian native forest furniture comes from happy, healthy, nutritious, rainbow flavoured, animal friendly, sustainably harvested forests.

There is no such thing in Australia, well not rainbow flavoured anyway.

The wood for all of their native Australian furniture and flooring ranges comes from what little remains of high conservation valued forests in Tasmania, Victoria, New South Wales and West Australia. in many cases these forests are clearfelled, burnt and endangered animals habitat destroyed. We want Harvey Norman to look into plantation and recycled furniture.

 - Print off some of our tags. They have been designed to print 3 to a page. They'd come out great on a thin card. Cut them out on the dotted lines and punch a hole through the perforation line and loop some twine or string through.
 - Dress in your finest Harvey Norman customer apparel with some of these stashed in your bag and have a wander through the store, discreetly attaching them to products made from Aussie wood.

When customers scan the tag it will take them to a video revealing the true picture of what happens in the areas they harvest the wood for their products from within Australia.

IMPORTANT NOTE – try and make sure you place this on furniture that is listed as being from Australian woods. It is labeled as tasmanian oak, blackwood, victorian/mountain ash, jarrah and a range of others. Whilst there is all manner of dodgy wood sourced from from forests overseas also stocked in Harvey Norman, we are trying to keep the focus for this campaign on Aussie stuff.
